
executives to better serve their communities, departments, or agencies. Each summer, participants from across the state will have the opportunity to sharpen their leadership skills and expand their professional knowledge.






college system for higher level administrative roles.

REDISTRICTING After the 2020 United States Census, school municipalities, and counties consulted with the Stennis Institute to begin their own redistricting process. The redistricting process begins with a current map and compares it to new population data. Looking through these new numbers with Census blocks, new lines are drawn, carefully considering population, geographical features, and demographics. A new proposal map is drawn and taken to the Board of Aldermen or the Board of Supervisors of the city or county, respectively. After discussions with the Board, a vote is cast on the entity's new lines.


